


Quiz time

- What is a global biodiversity hotspot?
 - An area rich in biology, in need of protection
 - Somewhere with a very hot climate
 - An area with a large population of one species
- Why do conservationists struggle to find Cross River gorillas?
 - They occupy inaccessible parts of the mountain
 - They aren't looking hard enough
 - Gorillas leave no trace so are impossible to find
- How can we identify individual gorillas?
 - Individual footprints
 - Depending on the name they respond to
 - Individual noses
- What measure can we put in place to protect Cross River gorillas?
 - There isn't anything we can do
 - Rainforest rangers
 - Train gorillas to hide better
- What's the biggest threat from hunters to the gorillas?
 - Traps being set for other animals
 - Hunters killing gorillas for food
 - Hunters confusing gorillas for other animals
- What is fragmentation?
 - Connecting lots of small areas to make one large one
 - A measure put in place to protect gorillas
 - Making one large area into multiple, small, isolated habitats
- What size population is better for health?
 - Small, safe from intruders
 - Medium, safe from intruders
 - The bigger the better, especially if there is connectivity
